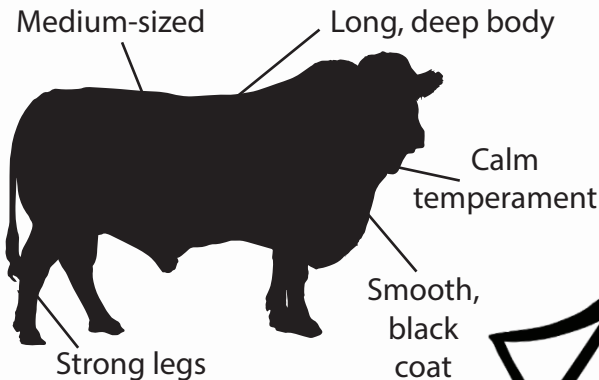

DID YOU KNOW?

The Drakensberger's skin is very special:

- The **dark colour** protects it from the sun.
- The **thick skin** protects it against diseases, such as those transmitted by ticks (natural resistance).

History of the Drakensberger

The Drakensberger is one of only three **indigenous cattle breeds** in South Africa. It was bred and developed here. The breed has been improved through strict selection according to scientific principles.



Where is the Drakensberger found?

The Drakensberger adapts easily to different environments and thrives throughout South Africa.

This cattle breed is **hardy** and can handle difficult conditions.

Their **strong legs** and **hard, buffalo-like hooves** help them to walk easily in any terrain.

- fertility,
- good growth, and
- good meat quality.
